
COMPANY PROFILE

01 | COMPANY HISTORY

Founded in 1985, McCloskey International started as a custom fabrication and design house. The trommel line was developed in the late 1980's and its success fuelled the expansion of the current product line and dealer network. In 2004, McCloskey purchased Viper International and started to develop a completely new range of vibrating screens. This partnership resulted in meeting the demands of the North American market with the design innovations and expertise available in Northern Ireland.

In 2018 McCloskey International announced the acquisition of Lippmann-Milwaukee Inc., a privately-held international manufacturer of aggregate crushing equipment for processing applications. Headquartered in Milwaukee, Wisconsin Lippmann was established in 1923 and has dedicated itself to producing the highest quality crushing equipment on the market. Currently McCloskey International continues to undergo rapid, sustainable growth in markets worldwide.

As of 2019, McCloskey is a part of Metso Outotec. Metso Outotec is a frontrunner in sustainable technologies, end-to-end solutions and services for the aggregates, minerals processing and metals refining and recycling industries globally. 02 | FACILITIES

McCloskey International's head office and factory in Ontario, Canada is an advanced 410,000 square foot production plant. The European facility in Co. Tyrone, Ireland houses the crusher and screener engineering office, as well as manufacturing of a full line of products across business units, including MWS Equipment.



In 2008, crushers were added to the product lines, and with overwhelming market demand a new crusher finishing building began construction in Canada in 2010. With facilities firmly in place, McCloskey then began expansion of its product ranges, including McCloskey Washing Systems, produced in N. Ireland and producing a full range of modular, mobile and static material and mineral washing equipment.

In 2018 Lippmann's production facilities added significant square footage to the worldwide manufacturing footprint of McCloskey, and operations commenced in 2020 to establish India as key manufacturing site.

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Headquartered in Helsinki, Finland, Metso Outotec employs over 15,000 people in more than 50 countries and its pro forma sales for 2020 were about EUR 3.9 billion. McCloskey trommels high production rates, versatility, ease of use and unrivalled strength has ensured the popularity with top soil producers, contractors and landscape supply operators.

With the largest screening areas in their class, McCloskey's S-Series and R-Series screeners are designed to give customers high output and durability even in the most demanding conditions, and deliver high production across industries. McCloskey International has manufactured the range of incline fines and scalping screeners to give customers high output and durability in any application from on-site construction and demolition, to large aggregates and quarry applications.





McCloskey trommels and screeners are ready to work in dual power and electric formats. Dual power boosts operational fuel efficiency, reducing costs, and along with full electric models are perfect where environmental, legislative, or noise constraints are a consideration.

McCloskey stackers have a unique and patented counter weight system and are designed to for versatile an productive stockpiling. With features such as the lift-axle, pivoting discharge conveyor, McCloskey stackers can swivel through a radius of 180° ensuring greater stockpile capacity without moving the installation, and less downtime for operators.

Based on its international reputation for top-of-the-line quality, innovation, and support, McCloskey International's range of crushers include cone, jaw and impact crushers. Like McCloskey screening equipment, they are designed to be the best business choice for material processing, as well as offer high standard of ease-of-use and safety standards for operators.

The America Parts Hubs are located in Ontario, Canada with an additional 10,000 sqm. facility in Milwaukee USA which opened in August 2016 to support the Market.



Fast fulfilment is key to any operation. All dealers worldwide hold in stock 2000 hour recommended spare parts lists for all machines sold in their market.

McCloskey is also committed to supporting its products throughout the lifecycle of the equipment with an extended warranty that lengthens the coverage period to four years. He extended warranty offering covers McCloskey original parts for two years longer than the standard warranty and includes a two year subscription 365SiteConnex telematics.

As a company that is involved in the handling and processing of the earth's resources, our company is committed protect the environment, with key initiatives including:


